FY 2010-2013 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment

In accordance with its Public Participation Plan, the Bloomington/Monroe County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is holding a thirty (30) day public review for **an amendment to the FY 2010-2013 Transportation Improvement Program**. Written comments on the proposed amendment will be taken starting on **September 27, 2011** and ending on **October 26, 2011**. The MPO Policy Committee is expected to vote on this amendment at their meeting on November 4, 2011.

A member of the Policy Committee requests the following amendment to the TIP:

- Removal of I-69 Section 4 Segment – The amendment request would remove the Indiana Department of Transportation's I-69 project from the TIP, including the preliminary engineering (PE) and right-of-way (ROW) phases.
