What is Homeward Bound?

Homeward Bound is a project of the Indiana Association for Community and Economic Development (IACED), and is a series of 11 annual walks taking place throughout the state. It is sponsored locally by area social service providers and community partners. **100% of funds raised by this annual event stay in Bloomington** to help people experiencing homelessness with shelter, food, and other emergency assistance needs.

Over \$505,000 has been raised in Bloomington alone and host to over 900 walkers. This money benefits those in our community who need it most.

This year's Homeward Bound walk will take place at **Sunday, April 15, 2012 at Third Street Park.**
