All videos posted by the submission deadline and deemed acceptable to the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Commission will be available for viewing and voting by the public. The winning video may be shown at the City of Bloomington Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Birthday Celebration on Monday, January 21, 2013 at the Buskirk-Chumley Theater.

Length: 45 seconds to 180 seconds

Eligibility: Anyone of elementary, middle, or high school age in the greater Bloomington, IN area

Prize: Apple iPad
