

## **Explore Peace by Creating a Mandala on Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, January 21, 2013.**

You are invited to join community volunteers to create your own mandala that expresses your playful exploration into the connection between peace and the environment. If you are over 10 years old and would like to fabricate a mandala that will be displayed in City Hall during the MLK 40 Days of Peace, and be part of a community stepping stone for a large public mandala, come to Showers City Hall at either 1:00 or 3:00 Monday, January 21, for one of two sessions.

A mandala is a geometrical design made to symbolically represent the cosmos from the human perspective, and originates from the Sanskrit word "circle". We will use materials from nature and scraps provided for you or you may bring your own, for our artistic creations. We'll begin with an introduction to what mandalas are, and end with your creation being photographed for the display. Your masterpiece will then be yours to take.
