Please vacate the north and south unimproved strip of Clifton between Hunter and East Second Street.

1. Safety would be enhanced to all owners by vacating.
The strip of Clifton is not necessary to the flow of traffic.
2. The opening and use of this section of Clifton would result in the decrease in the value of all of the surrounding property because of the close proximity of Clifton to improvements.





ORDINANCE 93-42

TO VACATE A PUBLIC PARCEL

Re: The Portion of S. Clifton Between Hunter and E. 2nd Street
(Robert J. Millican, Petitioner)

WHEREAS, I.C. 36-7-3-12 authorizes the Common Council to vacate public ways and places upon petition of persons who own or are interested in lots contiguous to those public ways and places; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner, Robert J. Millican, has filed a petition to vacate a parcel of City property more particularly described below;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of I.C. 36-7-3-12, a portion of City owned property shall be vacated. The property is more particularly described as follows:

The platted and unimproved, 500 block of South Clifton between Hunter and East Second Street bordered by lots 23, 24, 27, and 28 in the Kirkwood Heights Addition.

SECTION II. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval of the Mayor.
