## What is Homeward Bound?

**H**OMEWARD BOUND is a project of the Indiana Association for Community and Economic Development (IACED), and is a series of annual walks taking place throughout the state. It is sponsored locally by area social service providers and community partners. **100% of funds raised by this annual event stay in Bloomington** to help people experiencing homelessness with shelter, food, and other emergency assistance needs.

Over \$575,000 has been raised in Bloomington alone and is host to over 900 walkers. This money benefits those in our community who need it most.

This year's Homeward Bound walk will take place from on Sunday, April 14, 2013 at The Waldron, Hill and Buskirk Park (Third Street Park).

## Poverty in Monroe County

- In 2011, **24.7%** of Monroe County residents were living in poverty, the highest poverty rate in the state of Indiana—compare to the state of Indiana's poverty rate of 15.8%.
- In 2011, the poverty rate for children under 18 in Monroe County was **17.6%**.
- In the 2012-13 school year, at least **302** children in the Monroe County Community School Corporation experienced homelessness—a 67% increase from last year.
