

RESOLUTION 93-37

TO APPROVE THE USE OF REVENUES FROM MUNICIPAL BUILDING
VENDING MACHINES FOR CITY EMPLOYEE FUNCTIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

Funds received during 1993 through employee usage of vending machines located in City of Bloomington facilities shall be dedicated for use at functions for employees, elected officials and, board and commission members of the City.
