

ORDINANCE 81-3

To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, ZO/PCD-72-80, and recommended that the petitioner, Charles H. Dunn, Jr., et. al, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RH - High Density Residential, to ML - Light Manufacturing and industrial for property located at the northeast corner of Vernal Pike and Smith Road, more particularly described as follows:

A part of the Southeast quarter of Section 25, Township 9 North, Range 2 West, Monroe County, Indiana, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point that is 825.00 feet South of the Northwest corner of said quarter and in the centerline of Smith Pike, thence running South on said centerline for 1815.00 feet; thence leaving said road centerline and running East for 577.70 feet, thence North for 907.50 feet, thence West for 33.00 feet, thence North for 907.50 feet, thence West for 544.50 feet and to the point of beginning. Containing in all 23.38 acres, more or less. Subject to a 25.00 foot easement from the centerline of Smith Pike for County Highway right-of-way.

SECTION II. That an outline plan be approved, pursuant to Chapter 20.13 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, for the development of the above-described property.


SECTION III. The above-described property be designated, pursuant to Chapter 20.13 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, as a Planned Commercial Development.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.



SYNOPSIS

This ordinance would rezone 23.38 acres on the NE corner of Vernal Pike and Smith Road from RH to ML, approve an outline plan for industrial or commercial sites, and designate the site a planned commercial development. The proposed list of permitted uses includes everything in the ML zone plus a few additional commercial uses.
