

RESOLUTION 81-9

To Urge the Preparation of an Environmental Impact
Statement for the State Road 446 Relocation Project

WHEREAS, the proposed relocation of State Road 446 between Lake Monroe and State Road 46 could have potentially serious effects on Lake Monroe and the water supply of the City of Bloomington; and

WHEREAS, the potential problems have not yet been adequately studied by the Federal Highway Administration and the Indiana State Highway Commission to be able to make a determination that these problems are insignificant; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration and the Indiana State Highway Commission have failed to prepare an environmental impact statement despite evidence that the project could have significant impacts on the quality of the human environment in the area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

The Common Council urges the Federal Highway Administration and the Indiana State Highway Commission to delay any further development of the proposed relocation of State Road 446 until an environmental impact statement has been prepared.
