ORDINANCE NO. 73-69

WHEREAS Section 14.09.080 (a) (2) (A), "Other Noises Prohibited -- Standards for Unnecessary Noise", of the City Code of Bloomington prohibits the same act as Section 7.16.060, "Noisy Dogs", of the City Code of Bloomington; and

WHEREAS, the existence of both sections in the City Code Bloomington is unnecessary and confusing; and

WHEREAS Section 14.09.080 (a) (2) (A) is the better, more modern, more comprehensive section,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA:

Section 1. That Section 7.16.060, "Noisy Dogs," of the City Code of Bloomington be repealed.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
