

Do you have old and leftover medicine?

Not sure what to do with it?

What: “Clean Out Your Medicine Cabinet Day”

Where: All Marsh pharmacies (41 stores in Central Indiana)

When: Saturday, March 14th (9am-5pm) and Sunday, March 15th, 2009 (11am-5pm)

What kinds of medicine can I bring?

Medicine must be in original container with original label intact

- Pills, capsules and liquids (no aerosols, or inhalers)
- Sharps/needles (in hard plastic containers such as a "sharps container" or a laundry detergent bottle with resealable lid)
- Medicines that have the words “toxic,” “corrosive,” “flammable,” “alcohol containing liquids,” “reactive” or “ignitable” on them will *not* be accepted
- Only one type of medication can be in a single container – *no mixtures*
- No pill organizers will be accepted
- No controlled or illegal substances (check with your regular pharmacist if you're not sure whether a medicine is controlled)
