All children entering Kindergarten in Monroe County Community Schools must be five years old on or before July 1 (call 330-7700). In the Richland-Bean Blossom Schools it is also July 1 (call 876-7100).

Services to Families

- FREE computer-based referral services are provided to licensed child care homes and centers and to registered ministries. A Child Care Resource and Referral Specialist will perform a search according to parent specifications. Please call Childhood Connections toll free at 866-693-0672 or visit their website at www.childhoodconnections.org. Childhood Connections also offers Better Baby Care and IPICC (Indiana Partnership for Inclusive Child Care). These programs offer enhanced referrals including vacancy checks for parents of children with special needs and/or infants and toddlers and follow-up to ensure quality care is found.
- The annual Monroe County Child Care and Referral Easy Reference Guide is published and distributed by the City of Bloomington Community and Family Resources Department. Copies are available at the Monroe County Public Library. The Guide is also available on the internet at www.bloomington.in.gov/cfrd.
- The pamphlet Seek and Demand Quality Child Care is available free of charge from the Community and Family Resources Department office.

Services to the Child Care Industry

- Childhood Connections provides training and technical assistance for education professionals. Services includes licensing orientation training for new child care businesses, continuing education unit trainings, non-formal CDA classes, a resource library and enhanced services for caregivers of children with special needs and infants/toddlers. Child care providers participating in Paths to QUALITY are assigned a mentor to support them in this 4-level rating system. - Providers wishing to participate in the CCDF (Child Care Development Fund) program can contact TCC toll free at 1-866-921-6623. Submission of documentation on health and safety standards and a home/facility visit are required to become certified.

Child Development Chart

Developmentally speaking . . . the human infant is a learner from birth. The parent or caregiver has the opportunity for providing the touching, the talking, and the environment that will assure successful development. Knowing some of the signposts helps pave ways to play with the infant and toddler. If several behaviors are not observable in the child's development, it is recommended that the parents discuss the behaviors with their pediatrician.

The only time one (1) caregiver can care for twelve (12) children is when ALL children are 3 years of age or older.

Licensed Homes (LH)

Family child care homes are licensed and are located in a provider's home or a home structure. Homes are designed for multi-age group care. A home is limited to 12-16 children depending on the classification of their licensing. Their licenses should be posted, if you have a question regarding the number of children a provider should have. Specified child/staff ratios must also be met. See chart on opposite page.

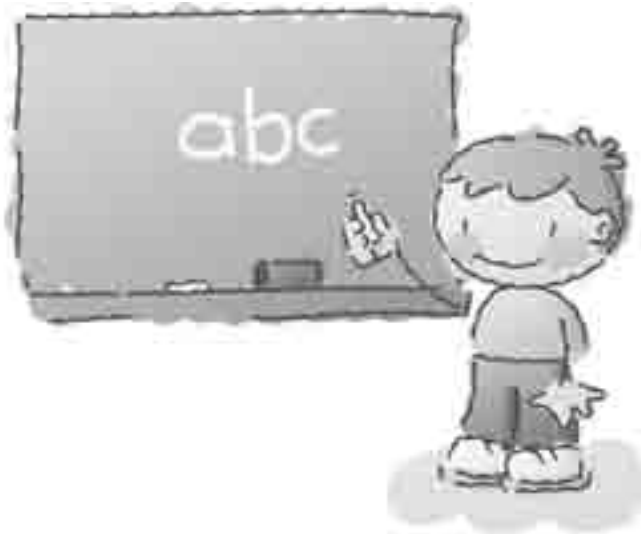
