BANNEKER CAMP



- The Banneker Center has offered the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) for 19 years
- SFSP is a Department of Education program that provides nutritious meals when the National School Lunch program is not in service
- The Indiana Department of Education reimburses organizations that prepare and serve meals to eligible children
- Banneker serves meals on-site, and provides daily programming for K-6th grade participants Monday-Friday in June and July
- Registration is \$10/week
- Of the 70+ participants registered, 81% qualified for free/reduced lunch within MCCSC

BANNEKER CAMP COVID-19 ADAPTATIONS



- Altered in-person camp capacity from 80 per day to 40 per day
- Offered free meal delivery program for participants who could not attend in-person camp
- Reduced trail group size and served meals outdoors when able
- Registration was available for all eight weeks of camp on May 1
- Created a COVID-19 emergency operations manual with guidance from CDC and Monroe County Health Department
