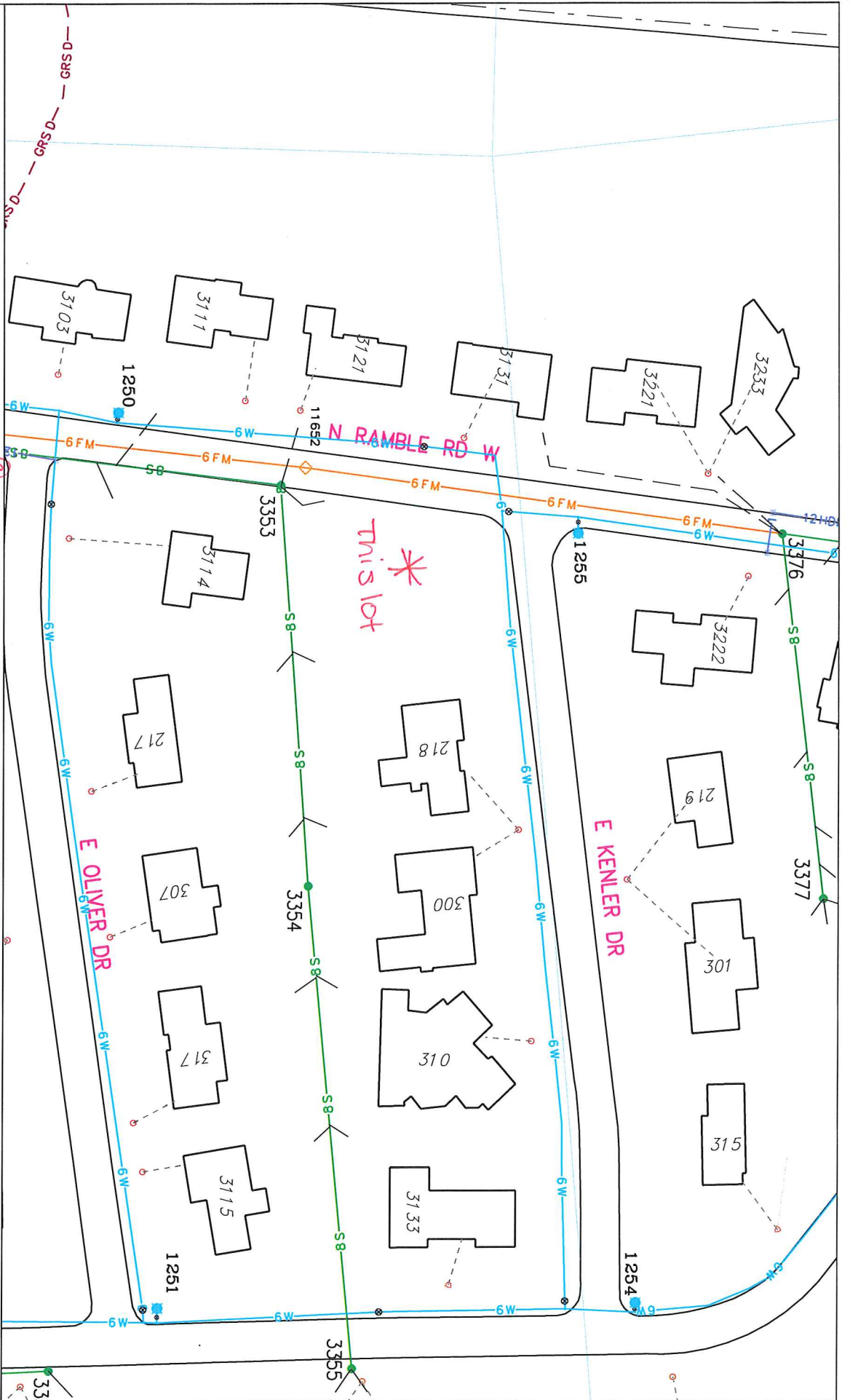
I spoke with Jane Fleig about your concerns for the vacant lot N of your residence. Per your request, a colleague and I did a site visit yesterday to look at the sinkhole issue. Since this is private property (and no utilities in the immediate area of the sinkhole), there is nothing that CBU can do to assist you with it, but we would recommend having the fallen brush and broken limbs/shrubs removed from the site to aid in the natural drainage on the lot. It was difficult to determine how deep the sinkhole was or to determine any additional information from the surrounding area with the piling of tree limbs and brush over it. Depending on whether or not you plan to develop the lot or leave it vacant would most likely determine what route you take for correcting the issues of the sinkhole.

After looking at photos taken during our site visit and contour information on GIS, Jane stated that you might contact Linda Thompson in City Planning & Transportation to see if she has any recommendations for you since she is more involved with site improvement projects involving drainage issues, etc. She is the Senior Environmental Planner downtown; and her contact information is 812-349-3533 or thompsol@bloomington.in.gov.

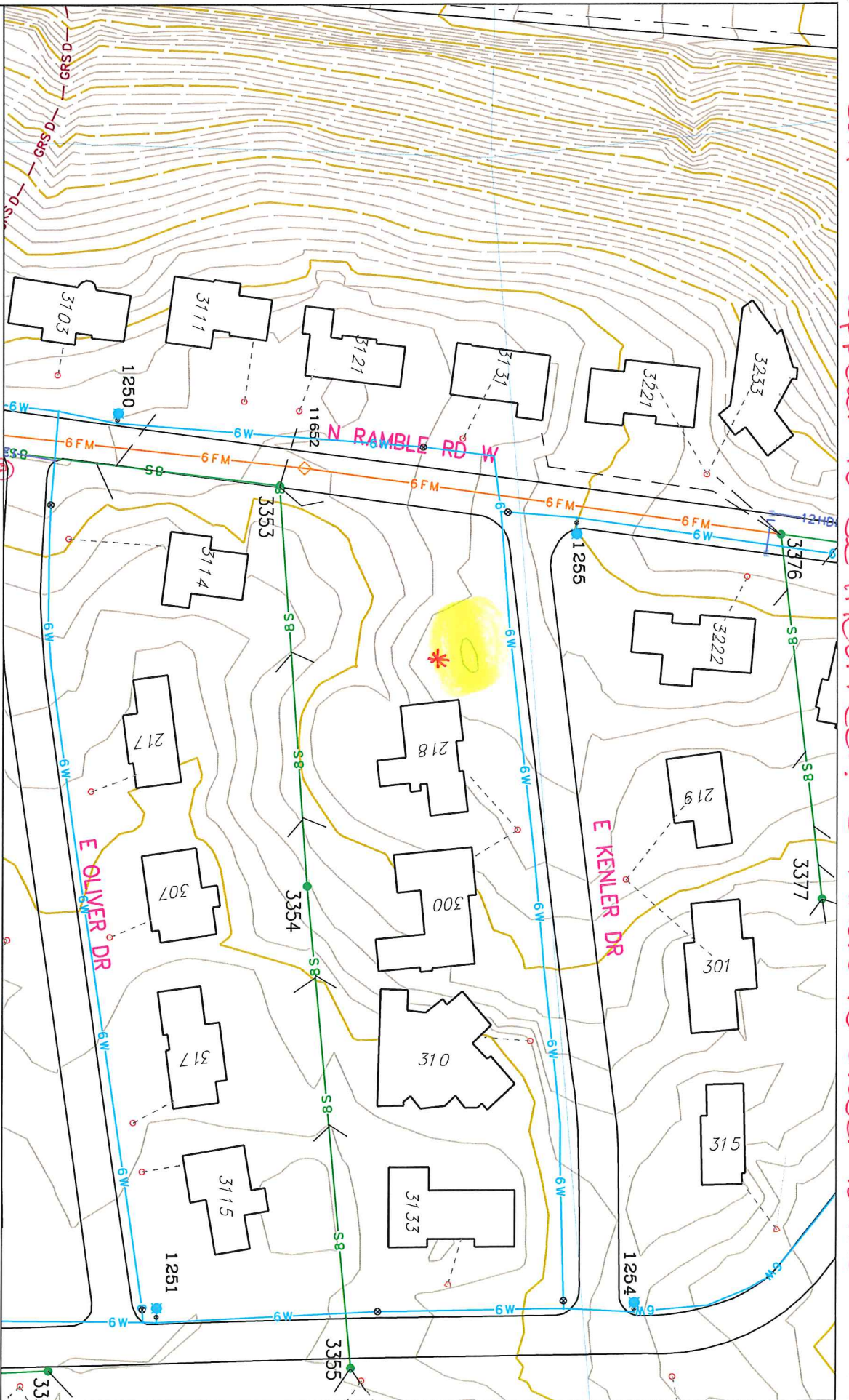

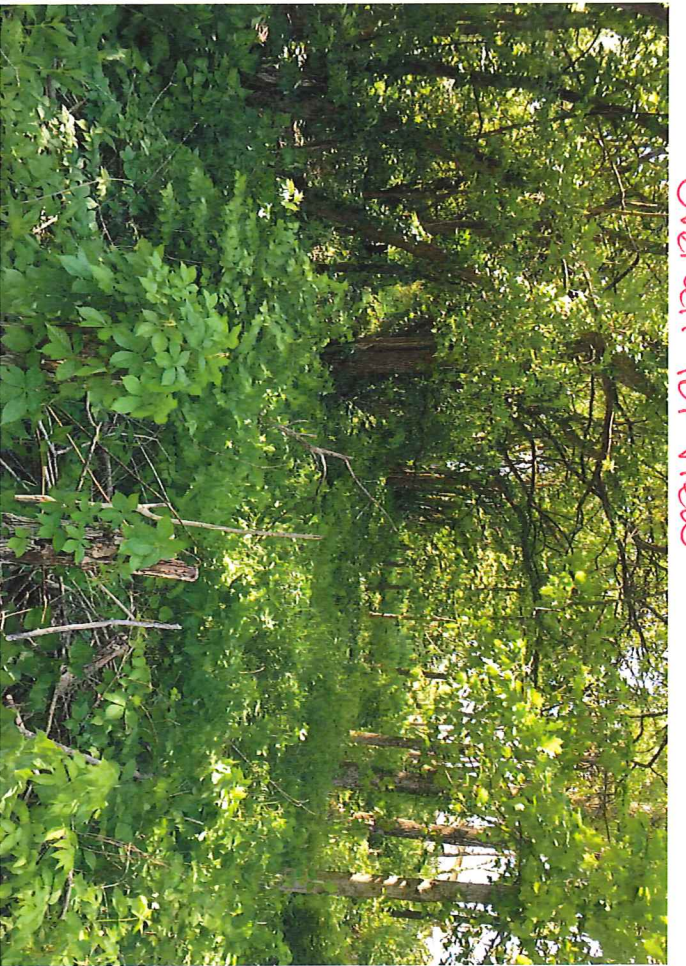

Overall lot view

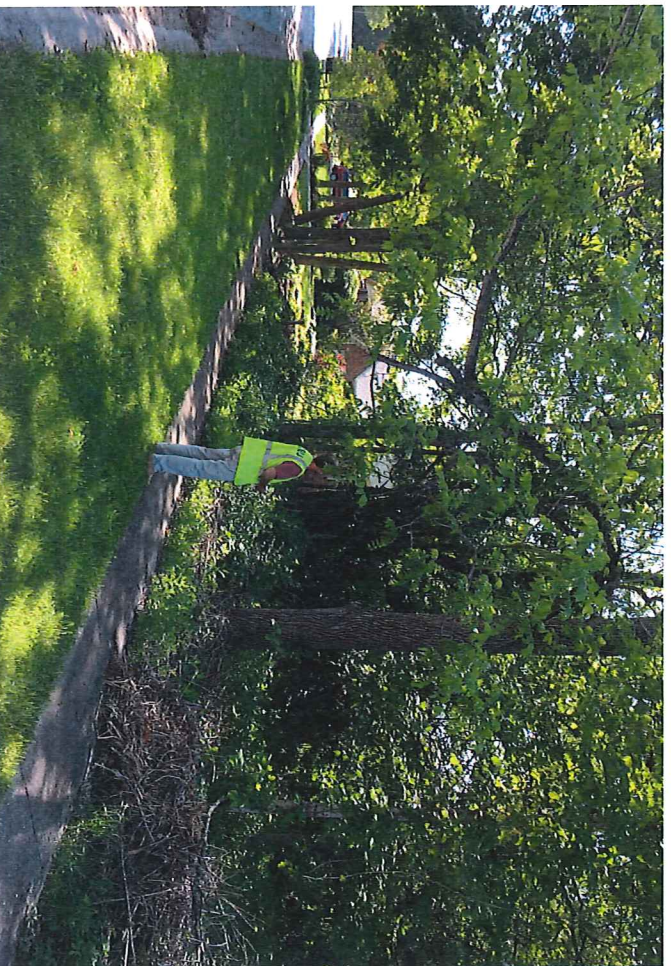
