



Be Informed!

Leash Law

Local ordinances require that your dogs and cats be kept on your own property. When off of your property, your dog must be on leash at all times.

Be Responsible

Local ordinances require that you clean up after your pet if they defecate on property other than your own. You must provide adequate food, water and shelter for your pets. Local ordinances also define excessive barking as a public nuisance for which tickets can be issued.

Don't Chain

Local ordinances prohibit a dog from being kept on a tether for longer than 10 continuous hours or more than 12 hours in a 24 hour period. There are also restrictions on the length and weight of the tether.

Report Abuse and Neglect

Call Animal Care and Control at 812-349-3492 to report animal abuse or neglect.

Spay and Neuter

Do your part to end pet overpopulation and have your pet spayed or neutered. Financial assistance is available.
