ORDINANCE 02-30

**TO AMEND ORDINANCE 01-28
WHICH FIXED THE SALARIES OF APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON FOR THE YEAR 2002
Re: Organizational Change in Community and Family Resources and
the Addition of a Position in the Police Department**

WHEREAS, the Community and Family Resources Department was recently notified by the State of Indiana that grant money used to fund child care subsidies would be reduced significantly on October 1, 2002; and

WHEREAS, in order to preserve the program and continue support for those members of our community who rely upon these transfer payments, reorganization of the CFR department is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Bloomington Police Department would like to add a position to manage and coordinate Computer Aided Dispatch and Records Management Systems;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 1 of Ordinance 01-28 shall be amended by deleting the following lines regarding job title, grade, and pay minimum and maximum as indicated below:

SECTION II. Section 1 of Ordinance 01-28 shall be amended by adding the following line regarding job titles, grades, and pay minimums and maximums as indicated below:



SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval of the Mayor.



SYNOPSIS

This ordinance amends the City of Bloomington Salary Ordinance for the year 2002 (Ordinance 01-28) by eliminating three Accounts Processor positions, three Program Assistant positions, and one Secretary position in Community and Family Resources and adding two Childcare Caseworkers and one Childcare Resource and Referral Specialist. Additionally, it adds a CAD/RMS Data Coordinator position in the Police Department.
