Rick Dietz reported on CoB activities:

- CTP Certified Technology Park: Charrettes are scheduled for next Tuesday, Oct 9. BDUAC members are encouraged to attend.
- Gig.U: Draft gigabit fiber RFP is nearing completion (when finalized RD will share with BDUAC). Next phase will be porting the Gig.U generic RFP to Bloomington's standards. Other Gig.U online tools for communities (demand aggregation) are coming along as well.
- Code for America: Bloomington did not get accepted for Code for America 2013 due to insufficient matching funds. Rick D attended CfA summit and 2014 is a real possibility. Building existing pledges, other options include TIF, partnering with Monroe County, etc.
- Google Summer of Code: Rick D and Cliff Ingham (ITS lead developer) will attend GSoC Summit representing Bloomington, the first city to participate in Google Summer of Code. RickD discussed some of the challenges of GSoC program including project coordination with GSoc students participating from India.

Dennis Cromwell and Mark McMath shared thoughts on overseas project management and vendor monitoring.

Mark McMath reported efforts at IUHealth to move to a single domain are progressing and the HealthLINC has brought in over \$2M to support its work with critical access hospitals.

Mike Trotzke suggest that Startup America might be a potential partner to CoB's CfA 2014 efforts. Mike then pivoted to inform the committee of his innovative Hoosier Gold initiative and accompanying dynamic and synergistic website.
