Habitat for Humanity of Monroe County "Cars for Homes" Program

Net proceeds generated by donated vehicle sales are used by Habitat for Humanity of Monroe County to build homes in partnership with families within our community! Plus, donating a car, truck, boat, RV or other vehicle is quick, easy, and your car donation may be eligible for tax deduction purposes if you itemize (consult the IRS or your tax advisor for details).

South Central Community Action Program "Wheels to Work" Program

A program that repairs donated cars and sells them to low-income families in Monroe County so they can seek or maintain employment. Donations are tax deductible based on the Kelly Blue Book value. Those wishing to donate a car may contact Christine Combs at 339-3447 (ext. 234) or christine@insccap.org

To buy a car through this program, applicants must be sponsored by a local social service agency case manager who can vouch for the client's need and ability to make the payments and take care of insurance, fuel and repairs. Applicants must also have a valid driver's license and have a true need for a vehicle to get to work or school or to upgrade to a better job.
