

RESOLUTION 92-06

URGING A THOROUGH CONSIDERATION OF THE EFFECTS OF THE PROPOSED ASPHALT PLANT

- WHEREAS, an asphalt manufacturing plant is proposed to be installed on South Rogers Street in Bloomington this spring; and,
- WHEREAS, the location of the proposed facility is adjacent to residential neighborhoods and in the vicinity of additional residences, places of employment, Bloomington Hospital, a day care center, a convalescent center, the new city park, and other potentially sensitive facilities; and
- WHEREAS, there is considerable public concern about the potential impact of such a facility on the environment, health and well-being of Bloomington area citizens; and
- WHEREAS, this concern specifically relates to the impact of this plant in terms of noise, odor, vibrations, increased traffic, damage to plant life, contamination of the nearby stream and the emission of metals and other possible pollutants due in part to the use of used motor oil; and
- WHEREAS, the City's Environmental Commission has expressed similar concerns;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

The Common Council urges that no further city permits be granted for this proposed project until the potential for the above mentioned effects is thoroughly addressed by relevant city, county, and state departments, any necessary measures to limit these effects are considered, and a full dialogue among the potentially affected public, state and local officials, and the permit applicant is achieved.



ILLINOIS CENTRAL R.R.




BUNGALOW PARK SUBDIVISION
