

ORDINANCE 00-43

TO AMEND ORDINANCE 00-31
WHICH FIXED THE SALARIES OF APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA
FOR THE YEAR 2001

(Changes in Positions for the Engineering, Parks and Recreation, Planning and Public
Works Departments)

- WHEREAS, the Planning Department wishes to delete the regular part-time Special Projects Coordinator position and replace that position with a regular full-time Long Range Planner; and
- WHEREAS, the Engineering Department seeks to delete one of the Project Inspector positions and add the position of Assistant Engineering Services Manager; and
- WHEREAS, the new positions described in the above paragraphs have been reviewed and assigned job grades by the Job Evaluation Committee; and
- WHEREAS, the Job Evaluation Committee has also reviewed the job descriptions for the Inclusive Recreation Coordinator in the Parks and Recreation Department and the Deputy Director in Public Works and has recommended an increase in grade from 5 to 7 for the former and a decrease in grade from 10 to 9 for the latter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance 00-31 shall be amended by deleting the following job title, grade, pay minimum and pay maximum for the following position, as indicated below:

SECTION 2. Section 1 of Ordinance 00-31 shall be amended by adding the following job titles, grades, pay minimums and pay maximums for the following positions, as indicated below:

SECTION 3. Section 1 of Ordinance 00-31 shall be amended by deleting one Project Inspector in the Engineering Department and changing the grade and salary range for the Deputy Director of Public Works and the Inclusive Recreation Coordinator in the Parks and Recreation Department, as indicated below:



SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval of the Mayor.





SYNOPSIS

This ordinance amends the Civil City Salary Ordinance (Ordinance 00-31) for the year 2001 at the request of the Planning, and Engineering departments. In particular, the Planning department has requested deleting one half-time Special Projects Coordinator position and replacing it with a regular full-time Long Range Planner position. The Engineering department has requested deleting a Project Inspector and adding an Assistant Engineering Services Manager. Lastly, this ordinance also incorporates recommendations from the Job Evaluation Committee to change the job grades for the positions of Inclusive Recreation Coordinator in the Parks and Recreation department and Deputy Director in the Public Works department.

Note: On November 15, 2000 the Council adopted Amendment 1 by a vote of 2-0, which deleted references to the proposed Project Manager position in the HAND department.
