

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 96-01

TO SPECIALLY APPROPRIATE FROM THE GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES  
NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED  
(Mayor's Office Personnel and Shower Center Utilities and Maintenance)

WHEREAS, it has now been determined to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget;
