

To Amend Title 2 Entitled "Administration and Personnel"
of the Bloomington Municipal Code

WHEREAS, a 1989 change to the Indiana Code has changed the amount that an Ordinance Violations Bureau may accept for payment of a fine from twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) to no more than fifty dollars (\$50.00); and

WHEREAS, currently, the Bloomington Municipal Code only allows acceptance by the City of no more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for a fine;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Chapter 2.27 of the Bloomington Municipal Code shall be amended to read "fifty dollars (\$50.00)" in lieu of "twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)" whenever such appears in the chapter.

SECTION II. Severability If any section, sentence, or provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any of the other sections, sentences, provisions, or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION III. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval of the Mayor.



SYNOPSIS

This ordinance amends Title 2 of the Bloomington Municipal Code to reflect the 1989 change to the Indiana Code allowing municipal corporations to collect fines of no more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) before necessitating the filing of a Complaint in court for collection.
