Dennis Cromwell reported on IU new RFP for wireless APs across IU campuses (6000). Vendor has been selected and deployment will be very rapid in the coming months.

Rick Routon reported on the fiber ring for the new Transit & Dispatch facility as well connectivity to Garage Art.

Mike Trotzke and Nina Onesti reported on the Combine conference. Workshops held on Friday were well attended. Main Stage was strongest yet, but would like to see attendance increase a little bit: estimate of around 225, but could manage 300.

Rick Dietz reported on CoB activities:

- CTP Certified Technology Park: Charrettes were successful and generated good ideas. Many attendees commented on the Print Building as being a usable space.
- Gig.U: Work continues on draft RFP. We'll be coordinating with IU about how to proceed in a unified way on this shortly.
- Google Summer of Code: Rick D and Cliff Ingham (ITS lead developer) attended GSoC Summit representing Bloomington, the first city to participate in Google Summer of Code. RickD led two sessions on the status and prospects for open source in government.
- Kualu: Kualu TIME is being tested within City ITS right now. GSOC yielded code additions to the Kualu Mobility platform.
