

ORDINANCE 94-23

TO AMEND TITLE 15 OF THE BLOOMINGTON CODE ENTITLED
 "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"
 (Ninth Street Between Washington and Morton)

WHEREAS, the Traffic Commission have recommended certain changes be made in Title 15 of Bloomington Municipal Code entitled "Vehicles and Traffic";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

Section I. Section 15.16.010 Schedule E shall be amended to delete the following:

Section II. Section 15.16.010 Schedule E shall be amended to add the following:

ONE-WAY STREETS

Ninth St	Washington St	Woodlawn Ave	West

Section III. Section 15.32.080 Schedule M shall be amended to delete the following:

NO PARKING ZONES

<u>Street</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>	<u>Side of Street</u>	<u>Time of Restriction</u>
Ninth St	College Ave	Walnut St	North	Anytime
Ninth St	Morton St	1st Alley East of Walnut Street	South	Anytime

Section IV. Section 15.32.080 Schedule M shall be amended to add the following:

NO PARKING ZONES

<u>Street</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>	<u>Side of Street</u>	<u>Time of Restriction</u>
Ninth St	Morton St	Walnut St	Both	Anytime
Ninth St	Walnut St	Washington St	North	Anytime
