

ORDINANCE 80-41

To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, Z0-14-80, and recommended that the petitioner, STONEBELT COUNCIL, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be changed from MQ to ML for property located at West 17th Street and State Road 37 Bypass more particularly described as:

A part of the West half of the West half of the Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-nine (29), Township Nine (9) North, Range One (1) West, Monroe County, Indiana, described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the aforesaid West half of the West half of the Southwest quarter, thence North 00 degrees 22 minutes 30 seconds West 683.71 feet to a point on the Easterly right of way of State Route No. 37; thence on said right of way North 19 degrees 26 minutes 28 seconds East 417.66 feet on the long chord of a curve, said curve having a radius of 3041.79 feet and an arc distance of 417.98 feet; thence on said right of way North 12 degrees 11 minutes 49 seconds East 259.69 feet; thence on said right of way North 15 degrees 30 minutes 30 seconds East 400.00 feet; thence on said right of way North 22 degrees 38 minutes East 201.56 feet; thence on said right of way North 18 degrees 35 minutes 01 second East 530.09 feet; thence on said right of way North 31 degrees 24 minutes 53 seconds East 107.88 feet; thence on said right of way North 84 degrees 31 minutes 35 seconds East 51.10 feet to a point on the East line of the aforesaid West half of the West half of the Southwest quarter; thence on said East line South 00 degrees 21 minutes 36 seconds East 2506.93 feet to a point on the centerline of West 17th Street and the South line of the aforesaid West half of the West half of the Southwest quarter; thence on said South line North 89 degrees 36 minutes West 495.72 feet; thence North 00 degrees 13 minutes 30 seconds West 150.00 feet; thence North 89 degrees 36 minutes West 150.00 feet; thence South 00 degrees 13 minutes 30 seconds East 150.00 feet; thence North 89 degrees 36 minutes West 20.00 feet to the point of beginning, containing 25.70 acres, more or less.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
