

ORDINANCE 80-87

To Amend the 1980 Utilities Salary Ordinance to  
Establish the Position of Senior Assistant Utilities Engineer

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Pursuant to the resolution of the Utilities Service  
Board of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, the salary and pay schedule  
for the following employee position of said Board from and after the  
24th day of October shall be incorporated into Section I of Ordinance  
79-65, Salary Ordinance for Utility Employees of the City of Bloomington:

Engineering Department

Senior Assistant Utilities Engineer . . . . . \$18,500

SECTION II. That from and after the 24th day of October, 1980,  
pursuant to IC 8-1-2-100, the following classified position, salary  
and pay schedule for Senior Assistant Utilities Engineer be incorporated  
into Section II of Ordinance 79-65, Salary Ordinance for Utility Employees  
of the City of Bloomington:

<u>PAY GRADE</u>	<u>CLASSIFICATION</u>	<u>SALARIED JOB RATE</u>
24	Senior Assistant Utilities Engineer	\$18,500

SECTION III. The rate shown as wage and salary for the position  
listed above is the maximum rate.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from  
and after passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
