

To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, PUD-48-80, and recommended that the petitioner, Robert E. Patton, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RS to RL for property located at 315 West Gordon Pike more particularly described as:

A part of the East one half of the northeast quarter of Section 20 and a part of the West one half of the Northwest quarter of Section 21, all in Township 8 North, Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point that is 757 feet South and 155 feet East of the Northwest corner of said Section 21; thence from said point of beginning and running South for 990 feet; thence West for 622 feet; thence North for 990 feet; thence East for 622 feet and to the point of beginning. Containing 14.14 acres, more or less.

SECTION II. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 and pursuant to Chapter 20.13 of the Bloomington Municipal Code that an outline plan be approved and that the above described property be designated a Planned Unit Development, Mobile Home Park.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
