

RESOLUTION 81-24

To Request the State Department of Corrections to Hold
a Public Hearing on the Proposed Location of a Work Release Center

WHEREAS, the State Department of Corrections plans to locate a Work Release Center in Bloomington but has not yet made a final decision on its location; and

WHEREAS, there should be an opportunity for affected neighbors and residents of the City to be heard regarding a specific location for the Center;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

The Common Council requests that the State Department of Corrections hold a public hearing on the proposed location of a Work Release Center in Bloomington prior to the Department's final decision on the location of the Center.
