

RESOLUTION 82-6

To Request the State Department of Corrections to Hold a Public
Hearing on the Proposed Westside Locations for a Work Release Center

WHEREAS, the State Department of Corrections plans to locate a Work Release Center on the westside of Bloomington at one of three sites; and


WHEREAS, residents of the westside want to participate in the decision-making process and they should be given the opportunity to do so;

WHEREAS, a prior hearing held in Bloomington was poorly moderated and allowed inadequate opportunity for presentations by groups other than the Department of Corrections;



The Common Council requests that the State Department of Corrections hold a public hearing on the proposed westside locations for a Work Release Center in Bloomington prior to the Department's final decision on the location of the Center, and suggests that the Department plan and conduct the hearing in cooperation with concerned westside community groups.
