

RESOLUTION 83-8

To Approve Utilities Service Board Appropriation Request S83-3401 for
Additional Sludge Facilities at the Dillman Plant

WHEREAS, Resolution 79-31 approved by the Bloomington Common Council on November 7, 1979, provides that construction and service contracts involving an amount of money in excess of \$10,000 shall be submitted to the Common Council in the form of an Appropriation Request prior to submission to the Board, and upon approval by the Board, shall be resubmitted to the Council in the form of an Approved Appropriation Request;

WHEREAS, Resolution 79-31 further provides that upon the request of three Councilmembers, the Appropriation Request shall be brought up in the form of a Resolution and that said Request shall not become effective until approved by the Council;

WHEREAS, The Utilities Department has submitted Appropriation Request S83-3401 and requested the matter be placed on the council agenda for consideration;




