

## ORDINANCE NO. 65-22

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON  
ZONING MAP, DATED JULY 18, 1950

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, passed a zoning ordinance and adopted a zoning map on July 18, 1950, which said Ordinance and map became effective on November 17, 1950, and

WHEREAS, said zoning Ordinance and map are now incorporated in the "Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, 1957", as Chapter 30 of said code, and

WHEREAS, any area annexed to the City of Bloomington, Indiana, is automatically classified as an R-1 ONE FAMILY ZONE by said Chapter 30, and

WHEREAS, The City Plan Commission has recommended that said Bloomington Zoning Map be amended by the rezoning of the said annexed area, now


THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, UNDER AUTHORITY OF CHAPTER 174, ACTS OF 1947, OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the Map entitled "Bloomington Zoning Map", dated July 18, 1950, be amended to rezone the following described land in the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, from its present R-1 ONE FAMILY ZONE classification to a B-1 LIMITED BUSINESS ZONE, to-wit:


A part of the Southwest Quarter of Section Thirty-five (35), Township (9) North, Range One (1) West, beginning at the Southwest corner of the said Section 35; thence running North for 331.5 feet and to the South right-of-way line of Edward Row Street, as laid out in the Hillsdale Addition; thence running North 89 degrees 50 minutes East over and along the South right-of-way line of Edward Row Street extended for 259 feet and to the West right-of-way line of State Highway 46-By Pass; thence running South 20 degrees 59 minutes East over and along the said West right-of-way of State Road 46 By-Pass for 152 feet; thence leaving the said Right-of-Way line and running South for 190 feet and to the township line; thence running West over and along the township line for 314.5 feet, and to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.




