

ORDINANCE NO. 65-19


AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, 1957, BY AMENDING SECTION 44 ENTITLED "PUBLIC HEARING ON PETITIONS: NOTICE: PUBLICATION: COST".

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, that Section 44 is amended to read as follows:

Prior to decision on petitions addressed to the board, the board shall hold a public hearing thereon, notice of which shall be mailed to the petitioner and to the owners of all property deemed by the board to be affected thereby as they appear in the current records of the county auditor and also advertised ten days prior to the public hearing in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city. The cost of notifying affected property owners and the cost of advertising the notice of the public hearing shall be borne by the petitioner.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.




