

ORDINANCE NO. 17, 1954

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON ZONING MAP, DATED JULY 18, 1950

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, passed a zoning ordinance and adopted a zoning map on July 18, 1950, which said ordinance and map became effective on November 17, 1950, and

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission has recommended that the Bloomington Zoning Map be amended by the rezoning of certain property, now

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the Map entitled "Bloomington Zoning Map", dated July 18, 1950, be amended to rezone from its present residential zone classification to B3 GENERAL BUSINESS ZONE, the property bounded by Second Street on the south, Morton Street on the west, the north line of the City owned Central Parking Lot and said line extended east to the north and south Alley between College Avenue, and Walnut Street on the north; and the north and south Alley between College Avenue and Walnut Street on the east, excepting there from Seminary Lot number Sixteen.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
