The City of Bloomington Utilities to Conduct Localized Fire Hydrant Flushing in the Fairwood Terrace/North Old State Road 37 areas on Thursday, April 7

Bloomington, Ind. – The City of Bloomington Utilities will do localized fire hydrant flushing of the water distribution system on Thursday, April 7. This is being done to address issues related to overall water quality.

Customers of the City of Bloomington Utilities in the following areas will experience low to moderate water pressure from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., while the hydrant flushing is taking place on that date.

- **East Fairwood Drive, East Woodland Drive, North Rural Street, East Richland Drive, and East Prairie Drive in the Fairwood Terrace Neighborhood.**
- **North Old State Road 37 from North Dunn Street to East Prairie Drive, East Bethel Lane, and North Christina Lane.**

Upon the completion of this project, a precautionary boil water advisory will be issued and remain in effect for the aforementioned areas until further notice.

While the precautionary boil water advisory is in effect, all drinking water should be boiled for a period of five minutes prior to consumption.

Additionally, customers are advised to flush their systems by running cold water through all fixtures, including the washing machine until the water runs clear.

A public advisory will be issued through local media outlets when the precautionary boil water order is lifted. The City of Bloomington Utilities will also announce the lifting of the precautionary boil water advisory on its web page at Bloomington.in.gov/utilities.
