



Q1 How often do you typically do the following on 4th Street?

Answered: 383 Skipped: 1




Q2 How often do you typically do the following on Rogers Street?

Answered: 382 Skipped: 2




Q3 How difficult do you find it to travel north/south on Rogers Street compared to other intersections?

Answered: 375 Skipped: 9




Q4 How difficult do you find it to travel east/west on 4th Street compared to other intersections?

Answered: 358 Skipped: 26




Question 5 sample responses:

Answered: 378 Skipped: 6




Question 6 sample responses:

Q8 How important are these improvements for the 4th/Rogers Street Intersection? (5 highest level of importance)

Easier to cross Rogers Street by foot	3.94
Easier to cross Rogers Street by bicycle	3.79
Improve lighting at the intersection of 4th and Rogers Street	3.63
Maintain motor vehicle access from Rogers turning onto 4th	3.61
Reduce congestion on Rogers Street	3.56
Maintain current motor vehicle access across Rogers on 4th	3.47
Reduce speeds on Rogers Street	3.37
Easier to cross 4th Street by foot	3.17
Easier to cross 4th Street by bicycle	3.13
Reduce congestion on 4th Street	2.71
