Junk in the Trunk Seller Information

- Junk in the Trunk is August 20, 2016 from 8a.m-1:00p.m. at the Frank Southern Ice Arena parking lot.
- Purchase of a Seller space gives you one space to park in and one space to set up. Only one vehicle per purchased seller space. We will be assigning spots this year. All spots are equal.
- There may be up to two Sellers per purchased Seller space.
- If seller is a group, not all group members are allowed to park their vehicle in the lot unless you have paid for additional spots. If you would like a block of spaces please let us know in advance. If additional spots haven't been paid for in advance only one vehicle will be allowed in the lot. So that we can assign consecutive spots.
- All Sellers must be over 18 yrs. old.
- This is a garage/yard sale. For the integrity of the event, businesses will not be able to participate. Sellers must register by **August 18, 2016**.
- The \$20 application fee goes towards advertising, marketing and administrative costs of implementing this event. (Marketing includes: Newspaper, Craigslist, Constant Contact, Posters, Yard Signs, fliers, program guide and social media)
- Items such as furniture, household goods, clothing, jewelry etc, may be sold at Junk in the Trunk.
- Food items, firearms, and weapons may **NOT** be sold at Junk in the Trunk. In addition food and drinks are also not allowed to be sold.
- Sellers should arrive **NO EARLIER** than 6am and **NO LATER** than 7am the morning of the event.
- Unless there are thunderstorms, Junk in the Trunk IS a rain or shine event.
- Sellers will **NOT** be able to move vehicles into or out of the selling area from 7:15 a.m. -1:15 p.m. The event runs from 8:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. In the event of an emergency please inform Bill Ream (onsite supervisor, 2016) and he will provide necessary precautions to exit safely.
- Sellers are responsible for cleaning up their trash and leaving the parking space clean. This includes removing all unsold items, empty boxes, and trash. Sellers must haul away their own trash.
- Sellers are responsible for their own merchandise.
- Restroom facility will be available in the parking lot via accessible port-a-let.
- Once event has officially ended and lot cleared of shoppers extra vehicles will be allowed in lot for load out. Until then, it will be blocked off and Bill Ream will let you through when parking lot is cleared or close to cleared out.
