The Common Council met nightly from August 22-26 to discuss the 2017 budget for the City of Bloomington as proposed by Mayor Hamilton.

Each department presented their budget for 2017 and received a preliminary vote from the council.

Throughout the remainder of August and September, the administration will work with the council and departments to prepare a final version of the 2017 budget for the City of Bloomington.

In October, the Common Council hears the budget and makes a final vote. At that time, council members may vote to reduce the budget but may not add to the budget.
