<u>Name of Film</u>	<u>Length</u>	<u>Description</u>
<i>Don't Laugh At Me</i>	2 minutes	Peter, Paul, and Mary sing "Don't Laugh At Me."
<i>Kids Just Want to Have Fun</i>	7 minutes	Kids with disabilities talk about their lives, health, or physical conditions and show that they are more like everyone else than different.
<i>Happy to be Nappy and Other Stories of Me</i>	30 minutes	Four stories about children with special qualities and differences who are empowered by their own uniqueness.
<i>The Heart Knows Better</i>	2 minutes	Whose hearts are these?
<i>Amazing Grace</i>	8 minutes	Grace, an African American girl, wants to be Peter Pan in the class play. Her classmates tell her she can't be Peter Pan because she's not a boy and besides, Peter Pan cannot be black. She wins the part and proves she can be anything she wants to be!
<i>Respect: Start the Ripple</i>	10 minutes	Students from Batchelor Middle School talk about what respect means to them. Film made by teacher Jeff Rudkin and his students.
