



Ice Cream Social Grant for Community Development

City of Bloomington Housing and Neighborhood Development Department

2009 Application Deadline & Granting Process

The **Ice Cream Social Grant** was developed to help neighborhoods build community by hosting an Ice Cream Social.

1. Applications will be accepted through October 19, 2009.

2. Funding Agreement. Once the application for an Ice Cream Social is approved, a Funding Agreement for allowable items to be reimbursed up to \$200.00 will be executed between HAND and the neighborhood applying for the grant. Until the Funding Agreement is signed by all parties, the City has no responsibility to reimburse the organization for any expense incurred before the Agreement is in place.

3. Project Completions. All projects receiving funding must be completed and have submitted the Ice Cream Social Grant Budget Claim Form, a one-page summary and pictures of the Ice Cream Social to HAND by Friday, November 20, 2009.

All promotional pieces receiving funding through this grant program must include the following mandatory grant identification statement: "Funding provided in part through the City of Bloomington's Housing and Neighborhood Development Department Neighborhood Improvement Grant Program."

Eligible Applicants: neighborhood communities,

- that have a majority of its members residing or doing business in a commonly recognized neighborhood; and,
- whose purpose, at least in part, is to improve the quality of life in that area (groups with such a purpose may be formed to complete this grant project only); and,
- that may include representatives from churches, schools, businesses, *and* other institutions operating in that neighborhood, as well as residents.

Who is not eligible to apply?

Groups or private residents who work on an individual basis:

- an individual business
- an individual government agency
- an individual private resident
- an individual institution
- an individual political group
- an individual religious organization
