## Homeward Bound Bloomington

Homeward Bound is a project of the Indiana Association for Community and Economic Development (IACED), and is a series of annual walks taking place throughout the state. It is sponsored locally by area social service providers and community partners. **Funds raised by this annual event stay in Bloomington** to help people experiencing homelessness with shelter, food and other emergency assistance needs.

Since 2009 Homeward Bound has raised over \$2,750,000 statewide for agencies that serve people experiencing homelessness.

Over **\$385,000 has been raised in Bloomington alone**. This money benefits those in our community who need it most. **100% has stayed local.**

This year's Homeward Bound walk will take place from 11:30-4:00 p.m. on Sunday, April 18, 2010 at Third Street Park.

11:30AM: Registration and pre walk entertainment begin  
 1:00PM: The walk steps off  
 2:00PM: Return to the park for music, food, fun, and team recognition
