**PUBLIC PARTICIPATION NOTICE:**

**FY 2010-2013 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment**

In accordance with its Public Participation Plan, the Bloomington/Monroe County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is holding a thirty (30) day public review for **an amendment to the FY 2010-2013 Transportation Improvement Program**. Written comments on the proposed amendment will be taken starting on **October 2, 2010** and ending on **October 31, 2010**. The MPO Policy Committee is expected to vote on this amendment at their meeting on November 5, 2010.

The Indiana Department of Transportation requests the following project be amended into the TIP:

- Section 4 of I-69 from May Creek to State Road 37 – The amendment request is to add preliminary engineering, right-of-way, and construction phases to the TIP for this segment of I-69.

Note: This request is an update and continuation of the Public Participation Notice conducted in July for the amendment of the entirety of Section 4. This segment from May Creek to State Road 37 is part of the larger Section 4 project which runs from US 231 to State Road 37.


