Patterson Pointe:

Caristo stated the members had reviewed this site in the past. He is trying to obtain any final recommendations from the members prior to the June Plan Commission meeting. This is an 18 acre site at West 3rd Street and Patterson Drive. It will be multi-story with mixed use. The members previously had recommendations which the developer has addressed. This included the east/west walking path adjacent to the creek be extended to the west property line and parallel parking on both private and public streets throughout the site. There has been a change in phasing and the developer is only looking at final approval for Phase I

which includes the street network construction, senior living facility and the creek restoration with the trail construction. Rosenbarger stated the plans showed corner build outs which cuts down on crossing distance; on street parallel parking with a sidewalk buffer for pedestrians giving the area more of an urban look. Rice stated he travels this area and the area that ties into the private street, Arch Haven, needed to be looked at for better bicycle accessibility. Rosenbarger stated the proposed interior street network seemed to allow for bicyclists to get away from the 3rd Street and Patterson Drive intersection.

The members talked about the entrance/exit onto 3rd Street across from Westplex Avenue. There needs to be internal pedestrian connections from the sidewalk to allow pedestrians to be able to get to 3rd Street to cross. This could include a raised crosswalk across 3rd Street. The members talked about the number of bike racks for the senior living facility. They feel that bike benches would be better utilized for this type of facility.

Wykoff stated the City has been placing the sandwich board sign that states “yield to pedestrians” at various locations on the B-Line Trail. The members should check out the sign.
