TO SPECIALLY APPROPRIATE FROM THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS NON-REVERTING FUND EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED (To Install Three Miles of Fiber Optic Cable Conduit)

- WHEREAS, the Common Council established the Telecommunications Non-Reverting Fund (Fund) by adopting Ordinance 96-31; and
- WHEREAS, Ordinance 96-31 provides that the Fund shall derive its revenues from cable franchise fees; and
- WHEREAS, Ordinance 96-31 dedicated forty percent (40%) of the cable franchise fees for the planning, design, development and construction of the City's telecommunications infrastructure; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington has determined a need to install conduit for fiber optic cable to create a fiber optic network infrastructure within the Bloomington community in order to stimulate the growth of information-based commerce;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. For the expenses of said municipal corporation, the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart from the funds herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same:

SYNOPSIS

This ordinance appropriates funds from the Telecommunications Non-Reverting Fund for the purposes of procuring and paying for the installation of conduit for fiber optic cable from South Rogers and Hillside to Seventh and Washington. Forty percent (40%) of cable franchise fees are designated for infrastructure projects of this nature. By appropriating funds at this time, the City will be able to share trenching and other construction costs with a private firm that is currently working in areas which overlap with the City's telecommunication infrastructure plans.
