APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 00-08

TO SPECIALLY APPROPRIATE FROM THE GENERAL FUND AND THE PARKS GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED (Approving Transfers within the General Fund for Two Departments and Appropriating Reimbursements or Grants to the General Fund and the Parks General Fund for Another Three Departments)

- WHEREAS, the City has determined the need to transfer General Fund monies within two departments; and
- WHEREAS, in particular, the City Clerk has requested the transfer of \$1,300 for temporary clerical assistance and ordinance and minutes books; and
- WHEREAS, the Information and Technology Services Department has requested the transfer of \$5,000 to purchase data backup equipment; and
- WHEREAS, the City has also received various reimbursements and grant of monies in its General Fund and Parks General Fund, which it desires to appropriate for immediate needs; and
- WHEREAS, in particular the City has received \$5,791.80 from the Bloomington Hospital for First Responder training and the Fire Department has requested that it be used to purchase additional equipment; and
- WHEREAS, the City has received \$43,632.13 in reimbursements from Indiana University and Monroe County and various state and federal grants, and the Police Department has requested that \$32,000 be used to cover unanticipated expenditures for overtime; and
- WHEREAS, the Parks General Fund has received various insurance reimbursements this year and the Parks and Recreation Department has requested that \$1,793.05 be used for repairing the damaged properties;

NOW, THEREFORE, APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 00-08 IS HEREBY SUBMITTED, DELETING THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE BLOOMINGTON DIGITAL UNDERGROUND FROM THE PREVIOUSLY SUBMITTED APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 00-07, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SYNOPSIS

This ordinance transfers monies from the General Fund that have been previously appropriated and appropriates reimbursements or grants made to both the General Fund and the Parks General Fund. In particular, it transfers General Fund monies within the Clerk and Information and Technology Services departments; appropriates reimbursements or grants to the General Fund for the Fire, Police and Public Works departments; and, appropriates insurance reimbursements to the Parks General Fund Monies for the Parks and Recreation department. This ordinance replaces <u>Appropriation Ordinance 00-07</u> previously submitted, deleting the appropriation for the Bloomington Digital Underground.

Note: On November 15th the Council voted 6-2 to adopt Amendment 01, which deleted the last "whereas" clause.
