

ORDINANCE 99-12

TO AMEND ORDINANCE 98-34 WHICH FIXED THE SALARIES OF APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON FOR THE YEAR 1999

Re: Adding a Children's Health Insurance Coordinator position in the Community and Family Resources Department

WHEREAS, the Community and Family Resources Department has recently received through the Community Health Care Foundation a three-year "Covering Kids" grant from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, which will provide full funding for a position to conduct outreach and enrollment for the new Children's Health Insurance Program; and

WHEREAS, Employee Services has reviewed the job description for this position and recommended a salary grade;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:


SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance 98-34 shall be amended by adding the following classified position, salary and pay schedule:

SECTION 2. If any sections, sentence or provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any of the other sections, sentences, provisions, or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval of the Mayor.
