ORDINANCE 99-19

TO AMEND <u>ORDINANCE 98-31</u> WHICH FIXED THE SALARIES FOR OFFICERS OF THE POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS FOR THE YEAR 1999 (Fire Department – Compensation for First Responder Certification)

WHEREAS, the Common Council desires to amend Ordinance 98-31;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Ordinance 98-31 shall be amended to add the following to the end of SECTION I:

Receipt of First Responder Certification.

Effective June 1, 1999, each firefighter who completes the course work and passes the examination to become a Certified First Responder during the calendar year shall receive a one-time lump sum bonus of five hundred thirty dollars and eighty-six cents (\$530.86). This lump sum shall be paid upon receipt of the certification and is in addition to the unit pay previously established herein for this certification.

SECTION II. Severability. If any sections, sentence or provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any of the other sections, sentences, provisions, or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval of the Mayor.
