ORDINANCE 98-02

TO VACATE A PUBLIC PARCEL Re: North/South Alley Located at 219 East Fourth Street (First United Methodist Church, Petitioner)

Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 98 of the original plat of the Town of Bloomington and running thence south 132 feet along the east side of said Lot 98 to the southeast corner of said Lot 98 thence running east 12 feet to the southwest corner of Lot 99 to the original plat of the Town of Bloomington and thence running north 132 feet along the west side of said Lot 99 to the northwest corner of Lot 99 and thence running west 12 feet to the point of the beginning.
