

RESOLUTION 95-12

TO APPROVE THE INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR ANIMAL SHELTER OPERATION FOR THE YEAR 1995

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington desires to contract with Monroe County, through the authority of I.C. 36-1-7-2, to provide services and facilities for the City of Bloomington Animal Control Department to operate the Animal Shelter for the care and control of animals;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, THAT:

The Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for Animal Shelter Operation for Fiscal Year 1995, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby approved, and the Mayor and Director of the Animal Shelter of the City of Bloomington are hereby authorized to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of Bloomington.

SYNOPSIS

This resolution approves and authorizes the Mayor and Director of the Animal Shelter to execute an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for 1995 for Animal Shelter Operation. The agreement provides that Monroe County shall pay the City of the sum of \$68,753 for 1995. This amount is based on a formula that accounts for the percentage of shelter operations attributable to animals coming from the county (44.57%) and the amount of fees generated by county residents (\$16,753).
