TO AMEND THE HIGHER DENSITY RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT CONDITIONAL USE MAP FOUND IN SECTION 20.10.09.00 OF THE BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE Re: 303 and 309 E. 7th Street and 312 N. Lincoln Street (CFC, Inc., Petitioner)

WHEREAS, in June of 1985 the Common Council adopted <u>Ordinance</u> <u>85-25</u> which incorporated a conditional use map for higher density residential development; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, ZO-44-94, and recommended that the petitioner, CFC Inc., be granted an amendment to this conditional use map and request that the Common Council consider their petition;

In Lot numbered three hundred thirty-eight (338) in the City of Bloomington, Indiana, as shown by the plat thereof recorded at page 4 of Plat Book 1 in the office of the Recorder of Monroe County, Indiana.

ALSO, A part of In Lot numbered three hundred thirty-seven (337), in the City of Bloomington, Indiana, as shown by the plat thereof recorded at page 4 of Plat Book 1 in the office of the Recorder of Monroe County, Indiana, being the Westerly Ninety-two (92) feet of even width off of said In Lot Three Hundred Thirty-seven (337).

ALSO, A part of said In Lot numbered three hundred thirtyseven (337), being the Easterly Forty (40) feet of even width off of said In Lot Three Hundred Thirty-seven (337), in the City of Bloomington, Indiana, as shown by the plat thereof recorded at page 4 of Plat Book 1 in the office of the Recorder of Monroe County, Indiana.

SECTION II. The Higher Density Residential Conditional Use Map is attached to this ordinance.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
