## **ORDINANCE 94-46**

## TO VACATE A PUBLIC PARCEL RE: Alley West of 1009 North Jackson Street (Bloomington Vendors, Inc., Petitioner)

WHEREAS, I.C. 36-7-3-12 authorizes the Common Council to vacate public ways and places upon petition of persons who own or are interested in lots contiguous to those public ways and places; and

SECTION I. Through the authority of I.C. 36-7-3-12, a portion of City owned property shall be vacated. The property is an alley located just west of 1009 North Jackson Street, more particularly described as follows:

Starting at the northwest corner of Lot 20 in Dolan Addition, to the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, thence north six (6) feet; thence west six (6) feet; thence south one hundred twenty-three and thirty-two hundredths (123.32) feet; thence east six (6) feet; thence north one hundred seventeen and thirty-two hundredths (117.32) feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION II. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval of the Mayor.
